Re: Vertical Height Increase Request for Waste Management of Texas, Inc.'s DFW Landfill

Dear Ms. Barron and Mr. Ferris,

Waste Management of Texas, Inc. ("WMTX") wishes to make a formal request to the Lewisville City Council for support and approval of a 50-foot vertical height increase for our DFW Sanitary Landfill (TCEQ Permit # 1025B), which is located at 1600 South Railroad Street, Lewisville, Texas.

As you know, WMTX is the owner/operator of the DFW Sanitary Landfill, which has been providing professional and environmentally responsible solid waste disposal services to the surrounding area for over 35 years. WMTX's DFW Landfill is currently authorized and permitted to operate by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). In accordance with our current TCEQ permit, the DFW Landfill adheres to a vertical height limitation of 625 feet Mean Sea Level (MSL). At this height limitation, WMTX estimates that at current volumes the DFW Landfill has seven (7) to nine (9) years of remaining operating capacity.

As you may also know, WMTX and the City of Lewisville entered into an Agreement related to the DFW Landfill on December 15, 2003. Section 6(B) of that Agreement provides that **"Any vertical or horizontal expansion of the Landfill shall require the written approval of Lewisville, which shall not be unreasonably, nor untimely, withheld."**

Prior to requesting approval from the TCEQ for this vertical height increase, WMTX first seeks to receive written approval from the City Council of Lewisville per the Agreement terms. If WMTX's request is approved by the City of Lewisville and then ultimately by the TCEQ, WMTX's requested 50-foot vertical height increase will add three (3) to five (5) years of additional capacity to DFW Landfill's operating life. Approval by the City of Lewisville for WMTX's DFW Landfill's 50-foot vertical height increase (to a new elevation limit of 675 ft MSL) is also similar to the approval the City of Lewisville provided to the City of Farmers Branch's Camelot Landfill on January 6, 2016.

The continued professional management of DFW Landfill's solid waste disposal capacity will provide a vital service as the surrounding area continues to grow and prosper into the foreseeable future. Waste Management would like to thank the City of Lewisville in advance for its consideration of this important request. Please let us know what additional information you may need in order to take the next appropriate step with our request.
